CATERING OPTIONS

FULL BOARD:

Rates include accommodation, early morning tea/coffee, brunch & dinner. A variety of herbal teas, coffee, fresh fruit and homemade cakes and biscuits (throughout the day). One game activity per day (either a guided walk or game drive). Rates exclude all beverages, mountain transfers, conservation fees, other activities and gratuities.

SELF-CATERING:

Self-catered rates include accommodation ONLY. All game activities, mountain transfers, beverages, meals, conservation fees, and gratuities, etc. are EXCLUDED.

STANDARD CHALETS - FULL BOARD ONLY

Accommodates 9 pax

2 x Queen, 2 x Twin (can be converted to King), 1 x Single for a Guide, driver, or pilot

FACILITIES: All rooms are en-suite with a shower and toilet. 100% cotton linen, hot water bottles, and solar-powered lighting. Close to the central living & dining area, lounge, and deck with swimming pool, over-looking the plains. Fully serviced, daily.

HAMASHA BUSH CAMP - SELF-CATERING ONLY

6 pax in two chalets, with 3 rooms

This camp is booked out on an exclusive basis. For this reason, we must apply a minimum charge of R4500 for the whole camp per night, if it is booked for less than 4 people.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to the fact that Hamasha Bush Camp is remotely situated, a 4X4 or high-clearance vehicle is required to reach the camp. Must be self-driven. **Two chalets:**

Chalet 1 - Sleeps 2 pax in a Queen suite with mini lounge, a pull out couch for 2 small children, en-suite bathroom, outdoor shower & outdoor bath.

Chalet 2 - Sleeps 4 pax in two bedrooms (one double & one twin). Both rooms have en-suite bathrooms & outdoor showers.

FACILITIES: Bedding, towels, fully equipped kitchen and outdoor braai. Firewood, fridge and freezer, gas stove with oven. Thatched lounge / dining room with fireplace and all equipment, washing up liquid, etc. **Hamasha is not serviced**.

Transfers

<u>Mountain transfer costs</u>: R300.00 each way per vehicle used, so R600 for a return trip/vehicle used

The last 3 kilometres to the entrance to Leshiba takes you up a relatively steep incline to the top of the mountain. The road is not suitable for vehicles with a limited ground clearance although the road is not limited to 4x4 vehicles only. Guests' vehicles can be left at the bottom of the mountain (meeting point) and Leshiba will then arrange a 'mountain transfer' at a cost specified above. **WE ARE UNABLE TO OFFER TRANSFERS AFTER DARK**. Guests must arrive before 15:30 due to the nature of the mountain road.

Please note

- Leshiba does not have a set transfer time therefore -
- Guests **must** pre-arrange their transfer **no less than 24 hours** prior to arrival.
- Guests must supply the lodge with a contact number in order to ensure their safe arrival.
- If the guest is delayed en route they must phone the lodge at least an hour before arrival in order that alternative arrangements can be made.

CHILDREN

Children of all ages welcome. Children aged 3-12 years pay 50% of the full adult rate if sharing with parents. Children 13 – 18 years of age pay the full adult rate. **Please note that the lodge has unprotected raised platforms and unfenced swimming pools. Children must be supervised at all times**.

Payment Details

A 50% deposit is required In order to confirm the booking. Balance is due 14 days before arrival.

All prices include VAT & are subject to change without prior notice

Cancellation policy:

Should the reservation be cancelled the following costs will occur:

Between six and four weeks of arrival	25% of the total amount
Within four and two weeks of arrival	50% of the total amount
Less than 48 hours of arrival	100% of the total amount
